Day 01 : Singapore Incheon Airport

Changi Airport - Check in your flight to Seoul

Seoul – Meet and great by guide. Transfer by KTX to Busan.

Gamcheon Cultural Village - The village had been transformed into a rainbow village. The place provides visual delight to visitors with murals and art. Known for its colourful terraced houses and its murals and art.

Day 02: Busan (Breakfast)

Songdo Ocean Cable Car - Enjoy the spectacular views of Songdo Beach bu cable car, along with sedimentary rock layers and rock formations and cliffs along the coastline.

Oryukdo Sky Walk - Experience the thrill of walking on water above a transparent glass bridge and thrilled with the view of the waveswhile looking down through the transparants floors.

Yonggungsa Temple - Haedong Yonggungsa Temple, one of the country's only shoreline temples that's also known as the most beautiful temple in Korea.

Haeundae Coastal Train - Take the retro-style world's first battery charged eco friendly train that bringing you to a unique picturesque views of Busan's sea. This beautiful port boasts a great view of the contrast between the skyscrapers of Haeundae on one side and the lights from the small fishing boats lining the coast on the other.

Day 03: Busan (Breakfast)

Taejongdae - A natural park of Busan with magnificent seaside cliffs. One of the famous sights in Taejongdae is the lighthouse sitting on a rock.

Huinnyeoul Culture Village - A charming coastal village located on the sloping cliff of Yeongdo in Busan. There are many interesting small alleys to explore throughout Huinnyeoul Culture Village. Such as Cafes with Ocean views, unique shop etc.

Kkangtong Market - The market is filled with people eating street foods from all over the world. So many choices.

Biff Sqaure - To the street lovers, Biff Square was known as street paradise for shopping for souvenirs and have great food street.

Jagalchi Market - The largest fish market in Korea and the heart of Busan, where you can find every type of seafood, selling both live and dried seafood. You can purchase the live seafood and bring to one of the restaurants for cooking.

Day 04: Busan/Pohang (Breakfast)

Homigot Square - Is the location of the easternmost point of the Korean peninsula, in what is said to be the "tail of the tiger". The most popular sight in Pohang Homigot Square is Sangsaeng's Hands, known as the "Hands of Harmony".

Space Walk - Take the stairway to heaven at Space Walk, South Korea's roller coaster. It's located atop the hills of Hwanho Park in the city of Pohang. Visitors can enjoy a 360 degree beautiful panoramic views of the cityscape as well as enjoy amazing sunsets and sunrises.

Yeongildae Beach - The largest beach on Korea's eastern coast. The beach has several lodging facilities and restaurants that offer fresh seafood. Yeongildae Pavilion on Yeongildae Beach is referred to as the "Floating" or "off Shore" pavilion. The pavilion is intended as a an observation deck providing extent views of POSCO, especially at night.

Day 05 : Pohang/Seoul (Breakfast)

Gyeongbokgung - Known as Gyeongbokgung Palace or Gyeongbok Palace, was the first palace built in the Joseon dynasty. Gyeongbokgung Palace is arguably the most beautiful, and remains the largest of all five palaces. You can dress in traditional Korean Hanbok touring at the palaces can make for a unique experience and a lasting memory.

Bukchon Hanok Village - A home to hundreds of traditional houses dated back to the Joseon Dynasty. Visitors with an opportunity to experience, learn and immerse themselves in traditional Korea culture

Gwangjang Market - Previously known as Dongdaemun Market. The market is one of the oldest and largest traditional markets in South Korea. A large wholesale market selling a variety of goods, including upholstery, imported goods, groceries, dried fish, traditional goods, and more.

Myeongdong - a shopping area packed with international fashion brands, luxury department stores and homegrown cosmetics shop
